<ul> <li>Arrange for a ride to and from Facility</li> <li>Go to pharmacy &amp; purchase Plenvu by prescription,use coupon if available</li> <li>For sore bottom:plain or aloe baby wipesDesitin or A&amp;D ointment</li> <li>Stop taking Coumadin or Plavix. Follow the instructions of your physician if alternative blood thinners are needed. Do not proceed without talking to your Gastro doctor if taking Brilinta or</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>□ Last chance to cancel the procedure without a cancellation fee</li> <li>□ For Co-payment questions call your Gastro doctor's office</li> <li>□ Stop supplements, vitamins, probiotics, iron</li> <li>No Coumadin or Plavix for 5</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Review diet instructions for the coming 3 days. Plan meals and shop to comply with instructions</li> <li>Confirm your ride to and from facility</li> <li>Stop any fiber supplements</li> <li>Eat well balanced meals</li> <li>BUT AVOID:</li> <li>Raw fruits</li> <li>Raw vegetables</li> <li>Nuts or popcorn</li> <li>Foods with small seeds such as tomato, sesame or melon seeds</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Drink AT LEAST 8 glasses of water or clear liquid during the day</li> <li>Eat well balanced meals BUT AVOID:         <ul> <li>Raw fruits</li> <li>Raw regetables</li> <li>Nuts or popcorn</li> <li>Foods with small seeds such as tomato, sesame or melon seeds</li> <li>No solid food after midnight</li> <li>Stop taking Eliquis, Pradaxa, Xarelto, Savasa after the morning dose (48 hours prior to procedure).</li> <li>Do NOT stop low dose (81mg) aspirin takon for heart or</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Drink at least 8 glasses of water and other clear liquids during the day</li> <li>Follow a strict clear diet ALL DAY</li> <li>5 or 6 pm: Mix 1<sup>st</sup> pouch of Plenvu with 16 oz water in the included cup, and follow with 2 more 16 oz portions of clear fluids</li> <li>Can have further clear fluids as you wish</li> <li>If you have any nausea take a 15-30 minute break then resume drinking clear fluids</li> <li>Verify that you have info you'll need to bring with you to facility</li> <li>Do not schedule any important activities on the day of procedure</li> <li>You may not drive or go home unaccompanied in a taxi or UBER etc after your procedure</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Beginning 4 or 5 hours before leaving home for your colonoscopy mix 2nd bottle of Plenvu with 16 oz water, followe by at least 2 more 16 oz portions of clear fluids</li> <li>After the last dose, do not eat or drink anything for 3 hours</li> <li>You may take regular prescriptions with small sips of water (but no blood thinners)</li> <li>If you take insulin shots, follow the instructions for lowered dose you were given for procedure day</li> <li>Be sure to bring:         <ul> <li>Insurance card or Medicare card</li> <li>Identification (CA driver's license, or ID card)</li> <li>Cash, check or credit card (Vis or Master Card) for co-paymen and/or deductible payment. (For co-payments or deductible amount, please contact your facility</li> </ul> </li> <li>Allow 2-3 hours at the facility</li> </ul>
or	or Plavix for 5 days				<ul> <li>Allow 2-3 hours at the facility before your driver will pick you up.</li> <li>Staff will call your driver to</li> </ul>



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Two days prior: Consider stopping all casual (not Dr. recommended) Aspirin or NSAIDS-no ibuprofen, Advil, Aleve, Naprosyn, Excedrin---only **Tylenol is okay or meds for migraine**
